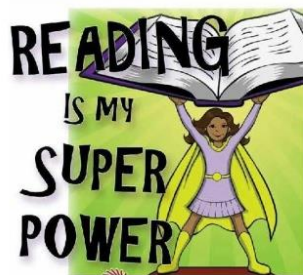
The Book Parade will begin at **11:00am**, students will then proceed to lunch. They may remain in casual clothes for the rest of the day.

## Emergency Water Infrastructure Rebate Scheme

The On-Farm Emergency Water Infrastructure Rebate scheme is available to eligible primary producers who can claim a rebate of 25% of the cost for; new purchases, and installation of pipes, water storages and water pumps, de-silting dams, and associated power supplies such as generators. This Rebate scheme can be applied to **costs incurred from 1<sup>st</sup> July 2018**. The maximum that can be claimed is \$25,000 per farm enterprise. The availability of rebates is subject to funds being available. No rebates will be offered beyond the allocated funding of \$12 million.

Applications close **30 June 2021** or when the funding allocation is exhausted, whichever occurs first.
