Attendance Matters

REMINDER:

- If your child is absent from school there
 is a requirement for you to provide a
 reasonable explanation for the absence
 within seven days. It is the Principal's
 discretion as to whether they deem an
 explanation as reasonable.
 - If an explanation is not received the students' absence will automatically be recorded as unjustified.
- Absences include late arrivals and early departures to and from school and also require an explanation.
- Absence notification methods that are acceptable are:

verbal (telephone or in person), reply text to **school Sentral**, email or written note.
