Attendance

If your child is absent from school, you are required to provide a reasonable explanation for the absence within seven days.

- Absences also encompass late arrivals and early departures, which similarly necessitate explanation.
- · Acceptable methods for notifying us of an absence include recording absence on the School Bytes App, responding to our Sentral text, making a verbal notification (either by telephone or in person), sending an email, or providing a written notice.
- · Should your child be absent due to illness for more than three consecutive days, a medical certificate must accompany your absence notification.

For extended absences, please contact the principal and complete an application form for extended leave prior to the anticipated leave period.

Beach to Bush

Next Tuesday, we're excited to welcome the Beach to Bush team to our school! Beach to Bush is Surf Life Saving NSW's flagship educational program, designed to teach primary school students essential beach and water safety. As the largest surf safety initiative in the state, this 45-minute presentation covers crucial topics like beach and inland water safety, sun protection, rips and waves, sea creatures, basic first aid, rescues, and seeking help from lifeguards. A curriculum-aligned guide will also be available for teachers to support all program content.

Children in regional and rural NSW areas often face higher risks near the coast due to less exposure to beach environments and potential surf hazards.

The program's key safety messages are relevant not only to the beach but also to rivers, dams, pools, and other inland waterways.
